Please read carefully and sign.

Your pet is scheduled for a procedure that requires anesthesia. We would like to take this opportunity to explain the pre-surgical, surgical, and post-surgical care your pet will receive to make this procedure as safe as possible.

Physical Examination

Like you, our greatest concern is the well being of your pet. Before placing your pet under anesthesia, we will perform a complete physical examination to identify any existing medical conditions that could complicate the procedure and compromise the health of your pet. We will examine your pet's eyes, ears, hair coat, skin, heart, lungs, teeth, gums, abdomen, lymph nodes, and look for external parasites.

Pre-Anesthetic Lab

Because there is always the possibility a physical exam alone will not identify all of your pet's health problems, we perform a pre-anesthetic profile (a combination of tests) prior to anesthesia. The tests we recommend are similar to and equally as important as those your own physician would run if you were to under go anesthesia.

It is important to understand that a pre-anesthetic profile does not guarantee the absence of anesthetic complications. It may, however, greatly reduce the risk of complications as well as identify medical conditions that could require medical treatment in the future.

- Mini Panel** The combination of blood tests we perform for pets less than **7** years old.

Anesthesia/Monitoring

We use the safest anesthetics appropriate for your pet's procedure. Our assistants monitor your pet throughout the procedure using specialized equipment.

Post Op Nursing Care

Our assistants stay with and monitor your pet during the post op recovery to ensure as smooth a recovery as possible.

Pain Management

The Shelby St. Animal Clinic dispenses pain medicine for your pet following this procedure.
